

MSU Pompon Winter Clinic

Participant Handbook

Welcome to Michigan State University Pompon's Winter Clinic! This is a skills based and speed learning focused workshop facilitated by current members of the MSU Pompon team. This handbook has been created to establish expectations for conduct during the program and proactively answer participant/parent questions.

- I. All participants must be registered and all forms must be filled out by the participant's parent/legal guardian prior to participation:
 1. Registration Form
 2. Consent Form
 3. Media Release Form
 4. Medical Treatment Authorization Form
- II. If you need to reach your child during the clinic, go to IM Circle Upper Gym (the gym you drop off and pick up your child/ren). There will always be a volunteer in that space and they can help you locate your child. If you have an immediate concern the day of the clinic and you must phone in, call (734) 751-7797 or (248) 762-1149 and someone should be able to assist you.
- III. Program Rules:
 - a. This clinic is centered on the speed learning of a pompon routine. The routine(s) taught are created for individuals who simply want to practice their pompon skills, or for current teams who need more material for their season. Individuals and teams at the advanced middle school, high school, or collegiate level are encouraged to attend. The goal is to improve upon skills relevant to the sport of pompon and to promote positive attitudes, team unity, and overall health and wellness.
 - b. No violence of any kind will be tolerated. Should there be an incident, participants will be removed from the program and the contact person on the registration form will be contacted to pick up the participant immediately.
 - c. Participants may not leave IM Circle during the program without a responsible adult.
 - d. Alcohol, tobacco, drugs, fireworks, guns, and other weapons are prohibited.
 - e. Sexual harassment, sexual abuse and other sexually inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated.
 - f. Harassment in violation of the University Anti-Discrimination Policy will not be tolerated.
 - g. Hazing and bullying (physical or verbal) will not be tolerated.
 - h. Misuse or damage of University property is prohibited and participants may be financially responsible for damage or misuse of University property.
 - i. Cameras and other digital recording devices are not permitted in showers, restrooms, locker rooms, and other areas where privacy is expected by participants.
- IV. Violations of Policy or Program Rules: In the event that a participant, group leader, or other individual associated with MSU Pompon Winter Clinic is alleged to have violated University policies or program rules, the individual will be immediately removed from the program pending investigation. Criminal charges may be pursued pending the outcome of the investigation.
